- Experience in evidence-based treatment approaches including CBT, health psychology/behavioral medicine, biofeedback & stress management, traditional psychodynamic models, TMS, and tele-psychology.
- Weekly hour-long individual and group supervision
- Biweekly hour-long didactic and interdisciplinary meetings
- Biweekly diversity meetings
- Weekly Postdoctoral Fellow luncheons (brown bag event)
